“Matters Regarding Arrangements In Response To The Epidemic”

Dear Parents:


As the Education Bureau has previously announced that the COVID-19 epidemic is still very severe so face-to-face classes and school activities will continue to be suspended until 10 January 2021. As in the past, during the suspension of face-to-face classes, our kindergarten will make appropriate adjustments to on-campus activities and related learning. We will also maintain close communication with parents. Parents are requested to understand and pay attention to the following arrangements.

Item	Content/Arrangements
Video Event	From 6 to 8 January, a video event will be arranged for each grade. For details, please refer to the video link in the mobile message to be sent later.
Homework/Small Tasks	For the homework/small tasks from 4 to 8 January, they will be sent via mobile message on 4 January (Monday). If the Education Bureau announces that the suspension of face-to-face classes will continue to be extended after 10 January, our kindergarten will arrange parents to come to school to collect the homework/small tasks from 11 to 13 January. For details, please pay attention to related messages on your mobile phone.
Teaching Video Clips	If the suspension of face-to-face classes continues to be extended, our kindergarten will start sending teaching video clips on 11 January. Parents are requested to pay attention to related messages on your mobile phone.
Birthday Party in January and February	If the suspension of face-to-face classes continues to be extended, the birthday party originally scheduled for 15 January (Friday) will be postponed and the celebration will be held later. The small birthday gifts will be distributed later together with the collection of the mini-tasks.
“Happy Bee”	9 January (Saturday) and 23 January (Saturday) are the online fall-in days for Happy Bee members. For details, please refer to the video link in the mobile message to be sent later.
“Seedlings of Christ”	16 January (Saturday) is the online fall-in day for Seedlings of Christ members. For details, please refer to the video link in the mobile message to be sent later.
“One Person One Flower”	When you collect the homework/small tasks, please return the “Dianthus Growth Diary” to the head teacher; the “2020 Dianthus Parent-child Planting Exhibition” originally scheduled for on 18 January (Monday) at school will be cancelled, but parents and their children can continue to plant dianthus at home. When face-to-face classes resume, children can share the joy of planting with everyone when they return to school.
Refreshment Fee	Refreshment fee is waived for January. After face-to-face classes resume, parents may let their children bring refreshments to school depending on the situation.

During the suspension of classes, the school will remain open. Parents are requested to pay attention to the following items to minimize the chances of your children being infected with COVID-19:

1. Maintain good personal hygiene, pay attention to the health of your children, cover your mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing, and wash your hands thoroughly afterwards;
2. Maintain a balanced diet, regular exercise and adequate rest to enhance the body's immune system;
3. Stay at home as much as possible and avoid allowing your children to go to crowded public places with poor air circulation.
