Dear Parents/Guardians,

First term of this year is about to end and the second term is soon start. In response to the lingering severe COVID-19 pandemic, Our School will follow the Education Bureaus will stay suspended until the beginning of the Lunar New Year holiday. Hence, our school is now arranging small tasks and online teaching from 11<sup>th</sup> January to 29<sup>th</sup> January, so parents can keep their children motivated and primed for learning during the suspension of face-to-face classes, and help them believe that they can finish their homework/small tasks and learn from online teaching at home every day following their teacher's schedule. Remarks:	*	If there are younger siblings studying in K1 or K2, their homework/small tasks will be released together with their older siblings'. Parents do not need to come to school twice at different schedules.
	*	Teacher will send a text message on 7 <sup>th</sup> January (Thursday) to remind parents to return the school homework or small tasks.
	*	To avoid overcrowded, please arrange one parent to collect the materials on the 1/F of the kindergarten.
	*	Parents are requested to bring their own environmental bags to carry the relevant items.
	*	Children taking private bus may arrange for the private bus to pick up their homework/small tasks or other items on their behalf. The detailed arrangement will depend on the communication between the private bus company and parents. Parents may also come to school personally to collect during the above-mentioned time slots.
	*	To reduce social contact and overcrowded, the Parents' Day for the first semester originally set on 29 <sup>th</sup> -30 <sup>th</sup> January will be conducted through phone conversation.

During the non-face-to-face instruction period, our school applied disinfectant coating on all school premises on 1<sup>st</sup> December to provide students with a hygienic and comfortable learning environment at best efforts. Parents and children should also continue to maintain personal and home hygiene and pandemic prevention measures, and pursue a regular and disciplined lifestyle, healthy eating and regular exercise to strengthen the body's immunity. Please stay at home as much as possible to keep your children away from crowded public places with poor air circulation.
