What do we need to do for Lent?

1. Lent is an important season in the Catholic liturgical calendar. It is the period of 40 days before the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus, which reminds us to pray, do good and be selfless.
Jesus loved everyone and was willing to carry the cross and be crucified for us. Therefore, during Lent, we are reminded to reflect on our behavior, to break bad habits - be they words or deeds - and prepare for the resurrection of Jesus.
